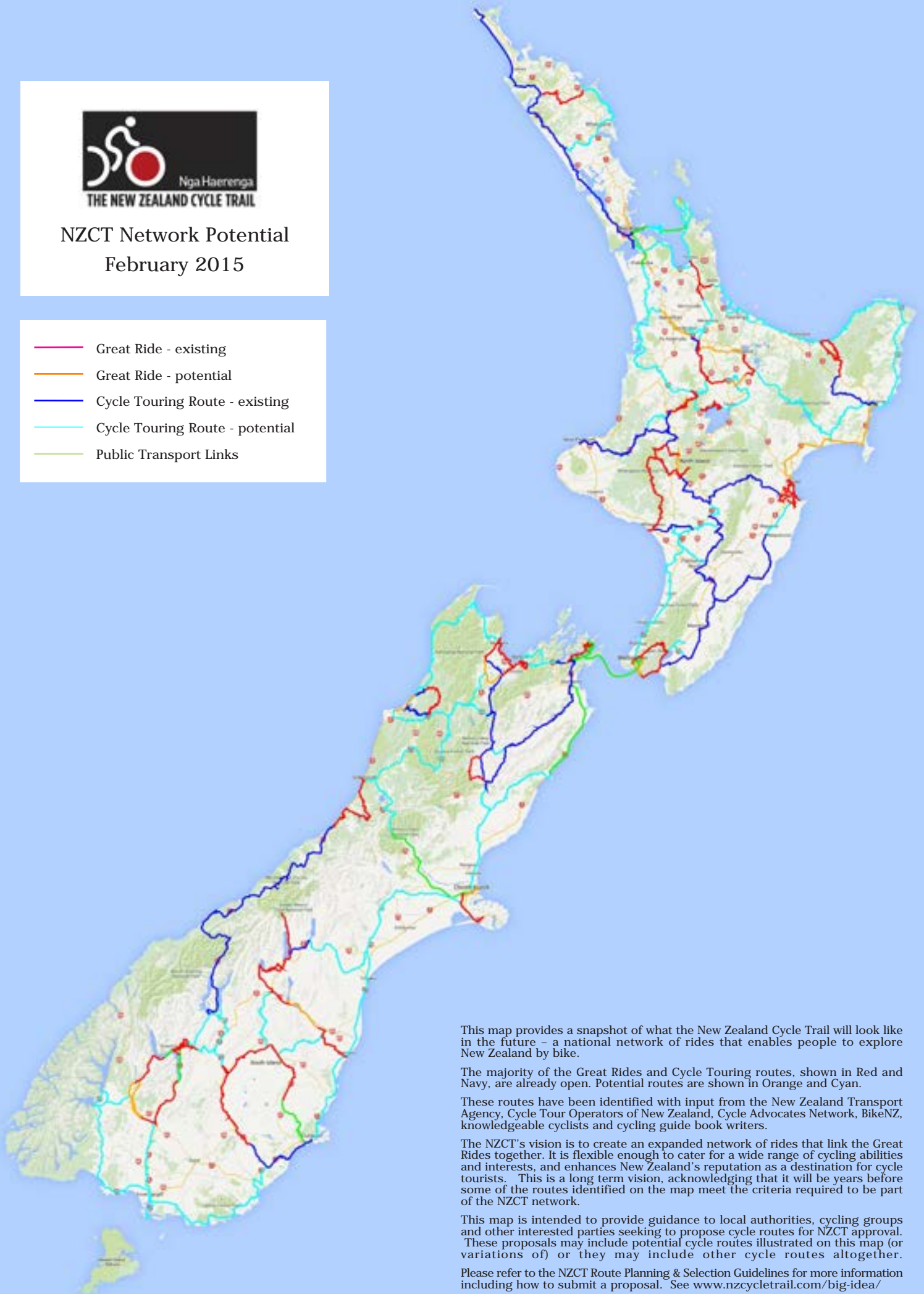




NZCT Network Potential February 2015

This map provides a snapshot of what the New Zealand Cycle Trail will look like in the future – a national network of rides that enables people to explore New Zealand by bike.

The majority of the Great Rides and Cycle Touring routes, shown in Red and Navy, are already open. Potential routes are shown in Orange and Cyan.

These routes have been identified with input from the New Zealand Transport Agency, Cycle Tour Operators of New Zealand, Cycle Advocates Network, BikeNZ, knowledgeable cyclists and cycling guide book writers.

The NZCT's vision is to create an expanded network of rides that link the Great Rides together. It is flexible enough to cater for a wide range of cycling abilities and interests, and enhances New Zealand's reputation as a destination for cycle tourists. This is a long term vision, acknowledging that it will be years before some of the routes identified on the map meet the criteria required to be part of the NZCT network.

This map is intended to provide guidance to local authorities, cycling groups and other interested parties seeking to propose cycle routes for NZCT approval. These proposals may include potential cycle routes illustrated on this map (or variations of) or they may include other cycle routes altogether.
